Samaritans is focused on building community, developing connections between clients and services, clients and families, and clients and the community.

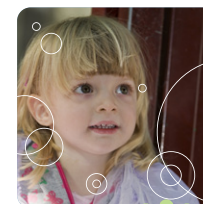

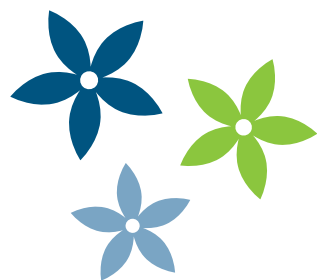

Samaritans Early Learning Centre Woodberry is a non-profit, community-based Child Care Centre located in Woodberry.

The Centre has 2 play rooms and children are grouped according to age. This allows for a much more flexible environment for the older children and a safer environment for the younger children. We “family group” the children in the mornings and afternoons to allow siblings to play together.

Our Philosophy

We believe that people have the right to live equally with others and to fully participate in and contribute to community life. We provide care to all people through acceptance, reconciliation, peace and dignity for all through our core values of compassion, integrity and justice.

Our centre provides a caring, challenging and stimulating environment with activities that allow children to develop to their full potential.

Samaritans early Learning Centre Woodberry offers your child a caring, safe and fun learning environment which encourages the development of skills and friendships.

What will my child be doing all day?

One of the ways that we provide care and education for your child is through our daily programme.

We incorporate the Early Years Learning Framework—Being, Belong and Becoming—into our daily programme. The children are free to choose from a range of experiences presented each day and are encouraged to follow their own interests.

Materials and experiences are open ended, enabling children to develop creativity and problem solving skills and allowing them to construct their own knowledge.

Who will be caring for my child?

Our centre is staffed by dedicated and qualified educators who are committed to providing high quality child care for your child.

Meals

We provide children with nutritious meals which are prepared in our kitchen by a qualified cook. We provide morning tea, afternoon tea, lunch and dessert.

Our weekly menu is reflective of the cultural diversity of our families.
