Hub Casework focuses on working alongside you to help open doors which provide choices, opportunities, and support that are determined by your own unique circumstances and picture of your future.

HOW CAN WE MEET YOUR INDIVIDUAL NEEDS?

The Hub Casework team supports young people in the Newcastle and Lake Macquarie areas, who are interested in working with the service on overcoming challenges that currently prevent them from achieving their hopes and dreams.

We believe in supporting young people to take charge of their lives so they can make decisions that are in keeping for what they want for their future.

Hub Casework recognises that young people are experts in the stories of their own lives and know what has been useful for them in the past.

The Hub Casework team will listen to you and will help to find out what will work best for you.

Hub Caseworkers are flexible and can meet with you at a safe place where you feel comfortable such as at our local office, your school, home or another venue.

WHAT IS HUB CASEWORK?

Hub Casework is a team of people who work alongside young people.

We provide **confidential** support to young people who are experiencing difficulties at home and in other areas of their life.

Hub Casework helps young people from 15 years up to 21 years of age, who are homeless or at risk of homelessness and/or dealing with drug and alcohol or mental health issues.

The Hub can also provide semi supported accommodation options for pregnant and parenting young women.

HOW CAN WE HELP YOU?

Hub Casework provide outreach support, advocacy and referrals to specialist services for young people who may be experiencing difficulties or seeking assistance in:

counseling identification employment
accommodation Budgeting
mediation sexual health parenting
centrelink payments relationships
drug and alcohol mental health issues
health issues brokerage
Income legal issues
counseling information
Disability Childcare education
living skills
