Early Intervention and Activities (EIA) Team Central Coast

EIA provides support to young people 9 – 18 by delivering school-based programs, skill-based and therapeutic programs and individual and family casework. Primary focus areas are Killarney Vale, Tumbi Umbi, Bateau Bay and Wyong, but the service is available to all young people in the Wyong Shire.

EIA can help young people with:

- Schooling issues and options
- Assistance with employment
- Relationships with friends and family
- Help to reconnect families
- Skill development
- Linking in with other services to suit young people's needs
- Self-esteem, confidence, positive communication and more

Intensive Family Support

Intensive Family Support (IFS) is an outreach service providing high level case management including counselling, parenting groups, advice and referrals, skill development and support to families. The program is designed to empower families to work together on achieving goals and outcomes that they determine.

Stepping Stones

This is a crisis refuge for young people aged 12–17 who are experiencing homelessness. There are five short term beds where young people can stay for up to three months and one emergency overnight bed. Stepping Stones aims to assist young people through case planning, where young people are encouraged to set their own goals and develop living skills and independence to work towards family restoration, medium term refuge accommodation or transitional housing.

- Emotional support and client-focused case planning
