Mid-North Coast



Samaritans operates from the Mid-North Coast region, down through Newcastle and the Hunter and on the Central Coast.

In the Mid-North Coast region, Samaritans operates a number of services, listed here.

Community

Emergency Relief Centre

Located in the Blue Cross Church, Victoria St, Taree.

these centres provide immediate emergency assistance to people in our community experiencing financial hardship. Assistance includes support with food, utility bills, pharmacy requirements, clothing and referral to other agencies.

Gambling Counselling

part of the NSW 'gamblingHELP' initiative, Samaritans gambling counselling offers help to those affected by gambling in Port Macquarie, Kempsey, Taree, Tuncurry and surrounding areas.

Great Lakes Manning Homeless Support Service

offers help to women, men and children facing homelessness in Taree and surrounding areas.

Community Hub

offers assistance to women and children facing homelessness in Kempsey.

Women's Refuges

provides crisis accommodation and outreach to women and their children who have experienced, or are experiencing, domestic abuse. The refuge is staffed only by women to provide support for women and children.

Operated in Taree and Kempsey

Disability

Taree Groups

a day program providing support, education and social activities for people living with a disability in Taree.

Supported Independent Living (SIL)

Samaritans operates support accommodation facilities in Taree and Pampoolah to increase opportunities for community participation, develop independent living skills, support autonomy and provide advocacy and assistance for people living with disability.

Individual Packages

for some people, the place they want to access support is in their own home, within the community they know. Through in home care services, such as respite, individuals can cater their care to their own personal needs.

Early Childhood Early Intervention

coordinates support for children with a disability aged 0-8 in the Mid North Coast region.

Family and Children

Permanency Support Program (PSP)

foster carers offering short to long-term accommodation for young people with intensive needs.

HIPPY

A 60 week curriculum of learning activities to assist children to achieve at school in Kempsey.

Youth

Taree Residential Service

provides supported care for young people aged 12 to 18 who are in the care of the Minister.
